

A TWO YEAR PROCESS

Determining the terms of the UK's EU exit, including the shape of its future access to the single market



1. A summit of the European Council will sit this week to discuss the results of the referendum.
2. The UK is expected to invoke Article 50 of the Treaty of EU.
3. The UK has two years to formally exit after notification under Article 50, yet separation could occur earlier if a new agreement is made.
4. The UK will need to concurrently negotiate a new trade agreement with the EU and all other countries it had free trade agreements with as part of the EU.
