ATWO YEAR PROCESS

Determining the terms of the UK's EU exit, including the shape of its future access to the single market



- 1. A summit of the European Council will sit this week to discuss the results of the referendum.
- 2. The UK is expected to invoke Article 50 of the Treaty of EU.
- 3. The UK has two years to formally exit after notification under Article 50, yet separation could occur earlier if a new agreement is made.
- 4. The UK will need to concurrently negotiate a new trade agreement with the EU and all other countries it had free trade agreements with as part of the EU.
