
40 YEARS OF FOSSIL FUEL PRODUCTION WORLDWIDE

While many European countries slowly reduce their fossil fuel production, other world leaders continue to increase their production. In 2004, **China** overtook the United States as the world's largest producer and now produces more than 100 quad BTU of fossil fuels - equivalent to a fifth of the world's total supply in 2019.



40 YEARS OF RENEWABLE ENERGY PRODUCTION IN EVERY COUNTRY

China and the United States are world leaders in renewable energy production, with China overtaking the U.S. as the leading producer in 2012. Globally, renewables account for around a quarter (23%) of electricity production, according to the IEA. Europe is another significant green energy producer, with 37.5% of its electricity sourced from renewables, according to the latest EU figures.
